2017 Earl Mayer Youth Bowler of the Year

- Bowlers 18 years or younger can earn valuable points at each sanctioned Youth Bowls Tournament across Ontario.
- The more you enter, the better your chances of being crowned "**Bowler of the Year**".
- If you attend all sanctioned Youth Bowls Tournaments, there is a bonus of 25 points towards your total.
- Points are available in both male and female divisions. Every participant receives one point for entering each sanctioned Youth tournament.
- The winner of the sanctioned tournament receives ten points, second place receives nine points, third place, eight points and so on down to tenth spot which gets 1 point.

The year-end award is a plaque.
